**TUNDRA** is a late heading Timothy with high dry matter yields. Its medium, erect growth produces a dense, uniform cover that's resistant to weeds. It has high even yields all season long, and produces very few stems. Tundra is has strong disease resistance and cold tolerance. It is a top choice for pasture renovation.
